

They shall audit the accounts of the trustees, which accounts shall be kept in due form, and shall be open at all times to the inspection of the committee, or of any member thereof. They shall determine from time to time the compensation, if any, which the trustees shall receive for their services. But the trustees shall have the right to have the settlement of their accounts and the amount of their compensation determined by the court, in case they are dissatisfied with the action of said committee. The acts of a majority of the trustees shall be the acts of the trustees; and the acts of a majority of the said committee shall be the acts of the committee.

SECTION 5. Said corporation shall have authority to receive, hold and apply to the uses of the corporation any other property, real or personal, which may be given or bequeathed to it, and to use the same for the objects herein set forth, subject to any restrictions, not inconsistent with this act, which are imposed by the donor or testator.

SECTION 6. The said corporation shall have power to do all acts necessary or proper to carry out the provisions of this act.

SECTION 7. The town of Dennis is hereby authorized to convey to the said corporation all its right, title and interest in the free public library on condition that it shall be maintained free to all the people of the town.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
